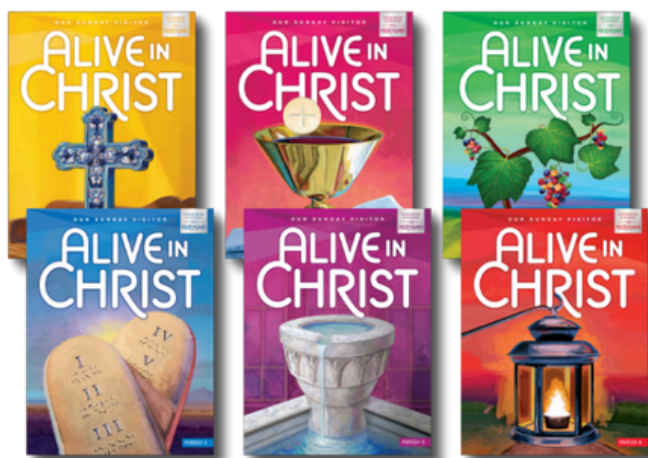


FORMING YOUNG DISCIPLES WITH EVANGELIZING CATECHESIS

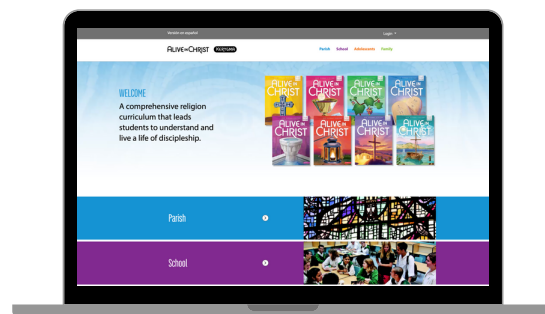

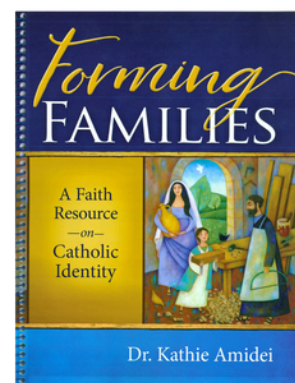
ALIVE IN CHRIST FAMILY FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM



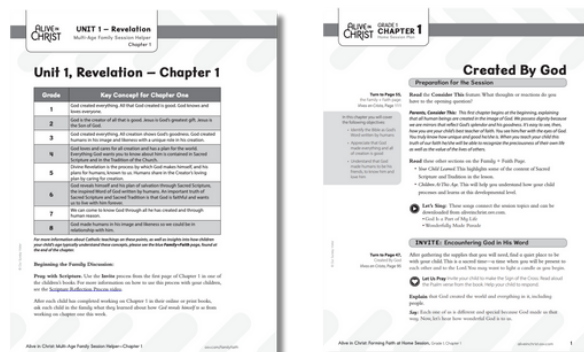

TWO MODELS OF FAMILY CATECHESIS



Grade Level + Family-Gathered Model

- Weekly grade level sessions in the parish for three weeks out of the month, with shared unit themes across grade levels
- 35+ monthly family-gathered sessions on unit themes (intergenerational gathering at the parish) included at no additional cost

Home Sessions + Family-Gathered Model

- Parent-led weekly sessions using home session plans available free to all parents
- Free multi-age family session plans for families with children of various ages so families can discover the faith at home together
- 35+ monthly family-gathered sessions on unit themes (intergenerational gatherings at the parish) included at no additional cost
